WCEC Women's Business Center Hosts Successful Business Pitch Competition 6th Annual Event to Empower and Celebrate Women-Owned Businesses

Chatham, NJ, June 20, 2024 - The WCEC Women's Business Center proudly hosted its 6th annual Business Pitch Expo on June 18 at the Eisenhower Corporate Campus in Livingston, NJ. The Business Pitch Competition significantly impacted participants, providing them with exposure, feedback, and financial support.
